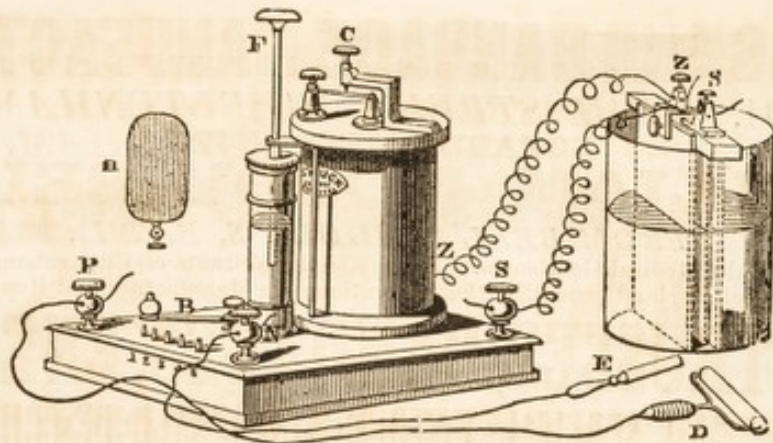

The remedial effects of Galvanism are chiefly dependent on the quantity of fluid passing, and but little on the intensity of the current. Dr. Farady has established beyond question that the size of the generating surface only (that of the first pair of plates) is concerned in the quantity of Electricity produced, and that the addition of other elements to the first pair does but add intensity to the current. The Instrument now under notice is specially constructed to embrace these facts. The generating Battery attached consists of a single pair of large plates, while, by a peculiar arrangement, the passage of the Electricity through the coil renders it intense. Moreover it possesses advantages over those ordinarily constructed of no small consequence. The coil of wire is *continuous*, the current passing thereby in one direction. The intensity of the shock also can be regulated with perfect facility; indeed the patient has such perfect command over the Instrument, by means of the two adjustments—the Regulator and Increaser—that he can apply the fluid to that delicate organ, the eye, or administer shocks so severe as to be perfectly unbearable.
